## ○ PEACE

- John 14:27: "Peace I leave with you. My peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Don't let your heart be troubled or fearful."
- Philippians 4:6-7: "Don't worry about anything, but in everything, through prayer and petition with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus."
- Psalm 29:11: "The Lord gives his people strength; the Lord blesses his people with peace."
- Isaiah 26:3: "You will keep the mind that is dependent on you in perfect peace, for it is trusting in you."
- Psalm 34:14: "Turn away from evil and do what is good; seek peace and pursue it."
- Romans 12:18: "If possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone."

## ○ SALVATION

- Ephesians 2:8-9: "For you are saved by grace through faith, and this is not from yourselves; it is God's gift— not from works, so that no one can boast."
- Romans 10:9-10: "If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved."
- John 3:16: "For God loved the world in this way: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life."
- Acts 4:12: "There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to people by which we must be saved."
- Titus 3:5: "He saved us, not because of the works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit."

## ○ FAITH

- 1 John 4:7: "Dear friends, let us love one another, because love is from God, and everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God."
- Romans 12:9: "Let love be without hypocrisy. Detest evil; cling to what is good."
- Ephesians 4:2: "With all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love,"
- 1 Peter 4:8: "Above all, maintain constant love for one another, since love covers a multitude of sins."

## ○ HEALING

- Jeremiah 17:14: "Heal me, Lord, and I will be healed; save me and I will be saved, for you are my praise."
- Psalm 107:20: "He sent his word and healed them; he rescued them from their traps."
- Isaiah 53:5: "But he was pierced for our transgressions, crushed for our iniquities; the punishment for our peace was on him, and we are healed by his wounds."
- James 5:16: "Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is very powerful in its effect."
- Matthew 9:35: "Jesus continued going around to all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and every sickness."

## ○ GUIDANCE

- Proverbs 3:5-6: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own understanding; in all your ways know him, and he will make your paths straight."
- James 1:5: "Now if any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God—who gives to all generously and ungrudgingly—and it will be given to him."
- Psalm 32:8: "I will instruct you and show you the way to go; with my eye on you, I will give counsel."
- Jeremiah 29:11: "For I know the plans I have for you"—this is the Lord's declaration—"plans for your welfare, not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope."
- Isaiah 58:11: "The Lord will always lead you, satisfy you in a parched land, and strengthen your bones. You will be like a watered garden and like a spring whose waters never run dry."

## ○ STRENGTH

- Isaiah 40:31: "But those who trust in the Lord will renew their strength; they will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not become weary, they will walk and not faint."
- Philippians 4:13: "I am able to do all things through him who strengthens me."
- 2 Corinthians 12:9-10: "But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is perfected in weakness.' Therefore, I will most gladly boast all the more about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may reside in me. So I take pleasure in weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and in difficulties, for the sake of Christ. For when I am weak, then I am strong."
- Psalm 46:1: "God is our refuge and strength, a helper who is always found in times of trouble."
- Ephesians 6:10: "Finally, be strengthened by the Lord and by his vast strength."

## ○ FORGIVENESS

- 1 John 1:9: "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

- Ephesians 4:31-32: "Let all bitterness, anger and wrath, shouting and slander be removed from you, along with all malice. And be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving one another, just as God also forgave you in Christ."
- Luke 17:3-4: "Be on your guard. If your brother sins, rebuke him, and if he repents, forgive him. And if he sins against you seven times in a day, and comes back to you seven times, saying, 'I repent,' you must forgive him."

- James 1:5: "Now if any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God—who gives to all generously and ungrudgingly—and it will be given to him."

## ○ PATIENCE

- James 1:4: "And let endurance have its full effect, so that you may be mature and complete, lacking nothing."
- Colossians 1:11: "being strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy."
- Romans 8:25: "But if we hope for what we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with patience."
- Psalm 37:7: "Be silent before the Lord and wait expectantly for him; do not be agitated by one who prospers in his way, by the man who carries out evil plans."
- Ecclesiastes 7:8: "The end of a matter is better than its beginning; a patient spirit is better than a proud spirit."

## ○ RESILIENCE

• 2 Corinthians 4:8-9: "We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed."

• James 1:12: "Blessed is the one who endures trials, because when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him."

• Romans 5:3-4: "And not only that, but we also boast in our afflictions, knowing that affliction produces endurance, endurance produces proven character, and proven character produces hope."

• 1 Peter 5:10: "After you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, establish, strengthen, and support you."

• Psalm 34:19: "Many adversities come to the one who is righteous, but the Lord delivers him from them all."

## ○ PURITY

• Psalm 51:10: "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me."

• 1 Timothy 5:22: "Don't be too quick to lay hands on anyone, and don't share in the sins of others. Keep yourself pure."

• Matthew 5:8: "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God."

• 2 Timothy 2:22: "Flee from youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, along with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart."

• 1 John 3:3: "And everyone who has this hope in him purifies himself just as he is pure."

## ○ HUMILITY

• Philippians 4:11-12: "I don't say this out of need, for I have learned to be content in whatever circumstances I  
but in humility consider others as more important than yourselves."

• 1 Peter 5:5: "In the same way, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. All of you clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble."

• Proverbs 22:4: "Humility, the fear of the Lord, results in wealth, honor, and life."

• Colossians 3:12: "Therefore, as God's chosen ones, holy and dearly loved, put on compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience."

• James 4:6: "But he gives greater grace. Therefore he says: God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble."

- 1 John 1:7: "But if we walk in the light as he himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin."
- Acts 2:42: "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread, and to prayer."
- Hebrews 10:24-25: "And let us consider one another in order to provoke love and good works, not neglecting to gather together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging each other, and all the more as you see the day approaching."
- Romans 12:16: "Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud; instead, associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own estimation."
- Ephesians 4:3: "Making every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace."

## ○ JUSTICE

- Micah 6:8: "Mankind, he has told each of you what is good and what it is the Lord requires of you: to act justly, to love faithfulness, and to walk humbly with your God."
- Isaiah 1:17: "Learn to do what is good. Seek justice. Correct the oppressor. Defend the rights of the fatherless. Plead the widow's cause."
- Proverbs 21:15: "Justice executed is a joy to the righteous but a terror to those who practice iniquity."
- Amos 5:24: "But let justice roll down like water, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream."
- Psalm 106:3: "Happy are those who uphold justice, who practice righteousness at all times."



## ○ DISCERNMENT

- Hebrews 5:14: "But solid food is for the mature—for those whose senses have been trained to distinguish between good and evil."
- Proverbs 3:21: "My son, don't lose sight of these—keep sound wisdom and discretion."
- 1 Kings 3:9: "So give your servant an obedient heart to judge your people and to discern between good and evil. For who is able to judge this great people of yours?"
- Philippians 1:9-10: "And I pray this: that your love will keep on growing in knowledge and every kind of discernment, so that you may approve the things that are superior and may be pure and blameless in the day of Christ,"
- Romans 12:2: "Do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may discern what is the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God."

## ○ GENEROSITY

- 2 Corinthians 9:6-7: "The point is this: The person who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and the person who sows generously will also reap generously. Each person should do as he has decided in his heart—not reluctantly or out of compulsion, since God loves a cheerful giver."
- Proverbs 11:25: "A generous person will be enriched, and the one who gives a drink of water will receive water."
- Acts 20:35: "In every way I have shown you that it is necessary to help the weak by laboring like this and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, because he said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'"
- Proverbs 19:17: "Kindness to the poor is a loan to the Lord, and he will give a reward to the lender."
- Luke 6:38: "Give, and it will be given to you: a good measure—pressed down, shaken together, and running over—will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you."

## ○ SERVING OTHERS

- Galatians 5:13: "For you were called to be free, brothers and sisters; only don't use this freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but serve one another through love."
- Matthew 20:26-28: "But among you it will be different. Whoever wants to be a leader among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first among you must be your slave— just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."
- 1 Peter 4:10: "Just as each one has received a gift, use it to serve others, as good stewards of the varied grace of God."
- Philippians 2:4: "Everyone should look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others."
- John 13:14-15: "If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example, that you should do just as I have done for you."
